

- Rutland White, Gray and Pittsford Valley marble ordered from saw will be crated and so charged unless order specifies no crating or delivery is to be made by carload. This rule does not apply to full size slabs, pieces with coped edges and bottom base grades.
- Duro and S.S. grades will not be furnished for monuments, markers or headstones, except in bottom bases.
- 4. In figuring cubic contents any fraction of an inch in height or width will be figured as a whole inch. Odd inches in thickness over 4 inches will be figured as the next even number of inches, (i.e., 0.6, 0.8, etc.) and any fraction of an inch in thickness over ¼ inch will be treated as a whole inch.

Estimates on any work not quoted in this list will be furnished upon request.

#### FINISHED MONUMENTAL MARBLE

We offer the following finishes:—HONE, CRYSTONE, SANTONE, TOOLED, STIPPLE and POLISH. It is recommended that designs be ordered in the finishes listed. Other finishes may be ordered and our price will be adjusted accordingly, but we will not be responsible for the effect of such alteration upon the appearance of the design.

## Monumental Finishing Rules

- Boxing of graded stock and crating of bottom bases are included in the prices of all finished work.
- Dowel holes will be drilled in all tablet designs 6 inches or less in thickness when ordered with bottom bases.
- Aluminum containers are furnished with vase designs and are recommended for all vases, particularly when used for planting. We supply containers only in sizes listed on page 15.
- Where inscriptions and epitaphs are shown on photographs such lettering is not included in the list price unless noted otherwise on price sheet.

#### Bottom Bases

Bottom bases of all finished work will be of Duro grade selected to harmonize with the die and with sanded surfaces unless otherwise listed or ordered.

Certain designs are listed with Selected Stock (S.S.) bottom bases to insure a better match with the die. These bottom bases will be furnished with sanded surfaces unless otherwise listed or ordered. They may, however, be ordered with Crystone, Santone, Tooled, Stipple or Duratex finishes at an addition to listed prices.
